- 1. What is the likelihood of the hazard resulting in an injury / illness?
- 2. What could the severity of the injury/ illness be?
- Can the hazard be eliminated or controlled immediately to reduce the risk?

The "HAZPAK" matrix should be used to determine the level of risk and what action should be taken.

**Level 1** = Top priority - Needs urgent attention

**Level 6** = Low priority – Take action when possible
